

Dancing Wand instructions

Supplies:

Cotton fabric: 5" x 30"

Contrasting cotton fabric: 5" x 30"

Matching thread

Dowel rod: 12" long

Fabric marker or tailor's chalk

Ribbon: 1 yard

Glue (optional)

1. Cut the fabrics according to fig. A.
2. Pin the two fabrics with right sides facing one another. Stitch around three sides of the fabrics together with 1/2" seam allowance, making sure to leave an opening at the end as shown in fig. B.
3. Clip the corners and turn the fabric tube right sides out. Press flat.
4. Turn under the end with the raw edges and press flat.
5. Wrap this flat end of the fabric banner around the dowel as snugly as it needs to be to stay in place. Pin and mark the line to sew using the fabric marker or tailor's chalk. (The line to be sewn is indicated by a dashed line in fig. C.) Then remove the dowel rod and stitch along this line.
6. Slide the fabric back onto the rod and add some glue if needed to secure the fabric. Tie with a ribbon to create streamers.

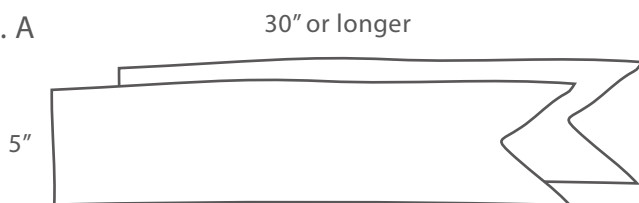
